ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR







Annually, the International Seminar of the International Cooperation Group of Brazilian Universities are attended by representatives of higher education institutions, diplomats, government authorities and representatives of international organizations from approximately 40 countries, located in five continents.

This year, the International Seminar will be held in partnership with Tor Vergata University and Roma Tre University, with the main theme: "International Academic Cooperation: Towards a Sustainable, Inclusive and Multicultural World."

The events are supported by the Embassy of Brazil in Rome, as part of the celebrations of the 150 years of Italian immigration to Brazil.

UNIVERSITY OF ROME TOR VERGATA







The **University of Rome Tor Vergata** was established in 1982 and is structured in 6 Schools (Economics; Law; Engineering; Humanities and Philosophy; Medicine and Surgery; Mathematics, Physics and Natural Sciences) which are organised in 18 Departments.

For the Academic Year 2017-2018 Tor Vergata offers 107 degree courses (bachelor, master and single cycle degree) and 31 PhD courses (taught in Italian or English).

As far as international relations are concerned, the University of Rome Tor Vergata counts more than 500 bilateral and cultural/scientific cooperation agreements with partner Universities worldwide to promote joint research programmes and academic exchanges. Among thosethe most prestigious Universities of Brazil, but also the George Washington University (for bilateral student mobility with traineeships from 4 to 8 weeks - for the first time in Italy); Harvard University (to support innovative teaching and research programmes, clinical practice, fight against cancer and exchanges for the best students and researchers); the University of Oxford; the University of California, Irvine (to promote cooperation in science and didactics through joint programmes and research projects, academic activities and training in fields of shared interest).

For Brazilians, it is not necessary to obtain visas for trips up to three months to Italy. You must only present a **valid passport with at least six months validity** from the date of entry into Italy.





OS CICLOS DO SISTEMA ITALIANO

1° CICLO

Tem como objetivo garantir ao estudante um adequado escopo de conteúdos científicos gerais. Os cursos de Graduação duram 3 anos, equivalentes a 180 CFU (Créditos de Formação Universitária). Tem como pré-requisito para a matrícula o diploma do ensino médio ou outro diploma obtido no exterior e reconhecido na Itália. A Graduação corresponde ao *Bachelor of Science* do sistema universitário europeu, definido em Bolonha em 1998.

2° CICLO

Tem o objetivo de fornecer ao estudante uma formação de nível avançado para o exercício de atividades de elevada qualificação em campos específicos. Os cursos duram 2 anos e equivalem a 120 CFU. Tem como pré-requisito para a matrícula o diploma de graduação o outro diploma obtido no exterior e reconhecido idôneo.

Em algumas localidades e para alguns cursos (Medicina, Farmácia) é possível matricular-se diretamente na *Laurea Magistrale* com o diploma do ensino médio ou outro diploma equivalente.

3° CICLO

Ele é dividido em três categorias:

Doutorado de pesquisa

Curso de Diploma de Especialização

Mestrado/especialização lato sensu de 2º nível (ital. Master)

Para além dos estudos universitários, geralmente divididos em *três ciclos*, o sistema italiano inclui: o **Ensino Superior de Belas Artes**, **Música e Dança**; as **Escolas Superiores de Mediadores de Línguas**, que emitem uma qualificação legalmente reconhecida equivalente aos diplomas universitários, e os Institutos Técnicos Superiores, que representam o segmento do ensino superior não universitário e que respondem às necessidades inovadoras do mercado e das empresas.
