ABOUT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR



Annually, the International Seminar of the International Cooperation Group of Brazilian Universities are attended by representatives of higher education institutions, diplomats, government authorities and representatives of international organizations from approximately 40 countries, located in five continents.

This year, the International Seminar will be held in partnership with Tor Vergata University and Roma Tre University, with the main theme: "International Academic Cooperation: Towards a Sustainable, Inclusive and Multicultural World."

The events are supported by the Embassy of Brazil in Rome, as part of the celebrations of the 150 years of Italian immigration to Brazil.



THE CYCLES OF THE ITALIAN EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

1st CYCLE

It aims to ensure the students have an adequate scope of general scientific content. Undergraduate courses last 3 years, equivalent to 180 CFU (University Credits). The prerequisite for enrollment is a high school diploma or another diploma obtained abroad and recognized in Italy. The degree corresponds to the Bachelor of Science of the European university system, defined in Bologna in 1998.

2nd CYCLE

It aims to provide students with advanced level training to carry out highly qualified activities in specific fields. The courses last 2 years and are equivalent to 120 CFU. The prerequisite for enrollment is an undergraduate degree or another degree obtained abroad and recognized as suitable.

In some places and for some courses (Medicine, Pharmacy) it is possible to enroll directly in the Laurea Magistrale with a high school diploma or other equivalent diploma.

HIGHER EDUCATION IN ITALY



3rd CYCLE

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It is divided in three categories:

RESEARCH DOCTORATE

It aims to provide the necessary skills to carry out highly qualified research activities. The course lasts **3 years**.

MASTER'S DEGREE/LATO SENSU SPECIALIZATION

The 2nd level Master's degree is a course aimed at **furthering university education** which is accessed on completion of the second university cycle. It has a workload of at least 60 CFU.

SPECIALIZATION DIPLOMA COURSE

It aims to provide knowledge and skills for the exercise of certain functions within specific professional activities. It makes it possible to obtain the necessary qualification to exercise these professions and aims to train specialists in certain professional sectors. A specialization course lasts at least 2 years.
